
Gentlemen:



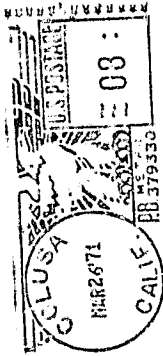
FIVE YEAR CHART

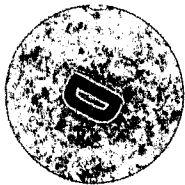
