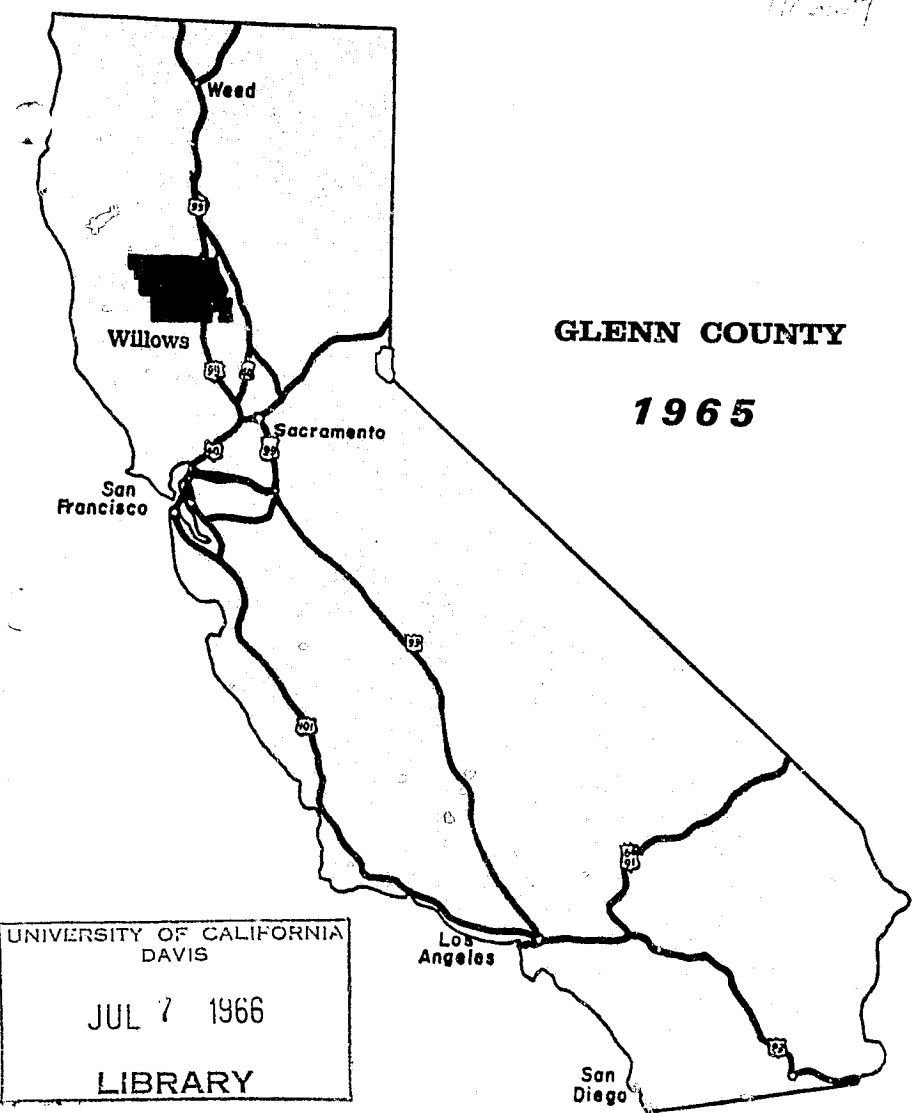

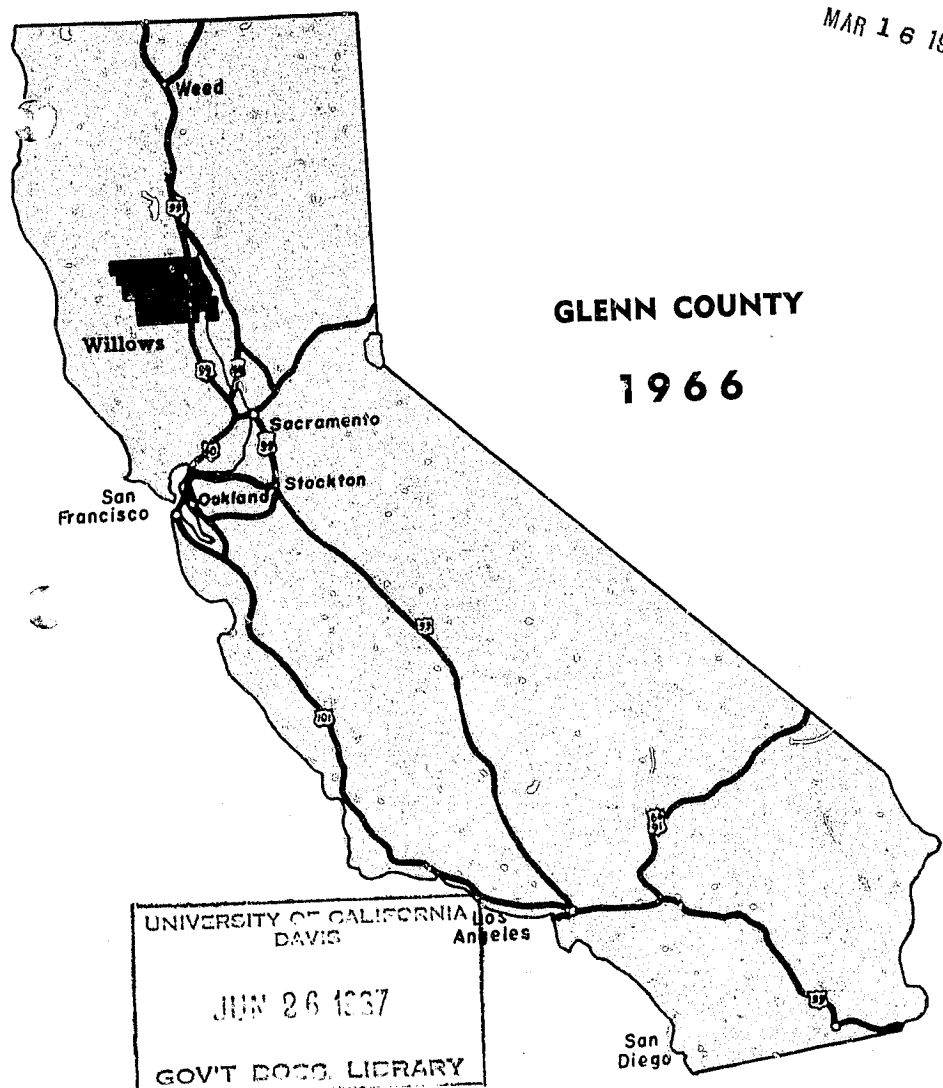


This Annual Crop and Livestock Report is compiled in accordance with Section 65.5 of the California Agricultural Code.


This Annual Crop and Livestock Report is compiled in accordance with Section 2279 of the California Agricultural Code.

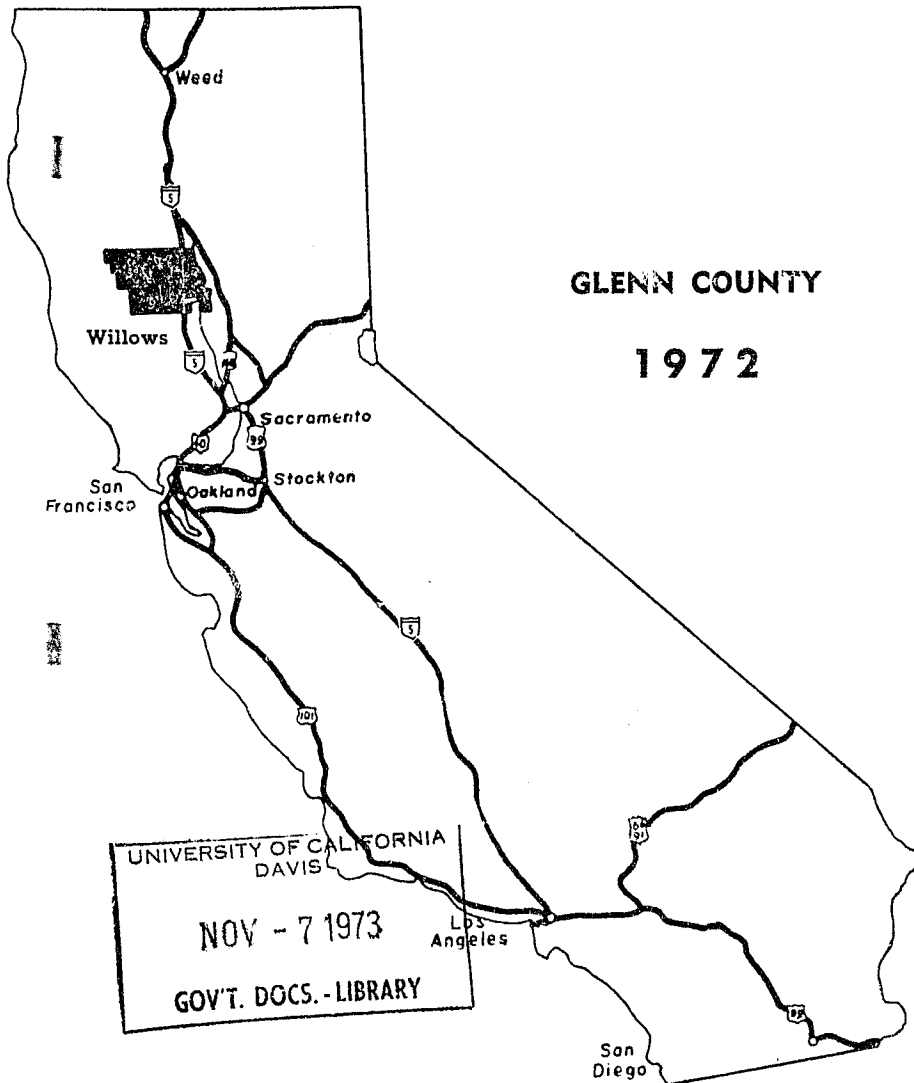

The year 1972 was characterized by disaster; the worst drought in 33 years, the most severe freeze since 1932, and finally, unusually heavy fall rains. In spite of these obstacles, the gross value of agricultural production set a new high in 1972 at \$55,387,600. However, inflation plus the natural disasters added considerably to the cost of production, so gross value should not be equated with net farm income.

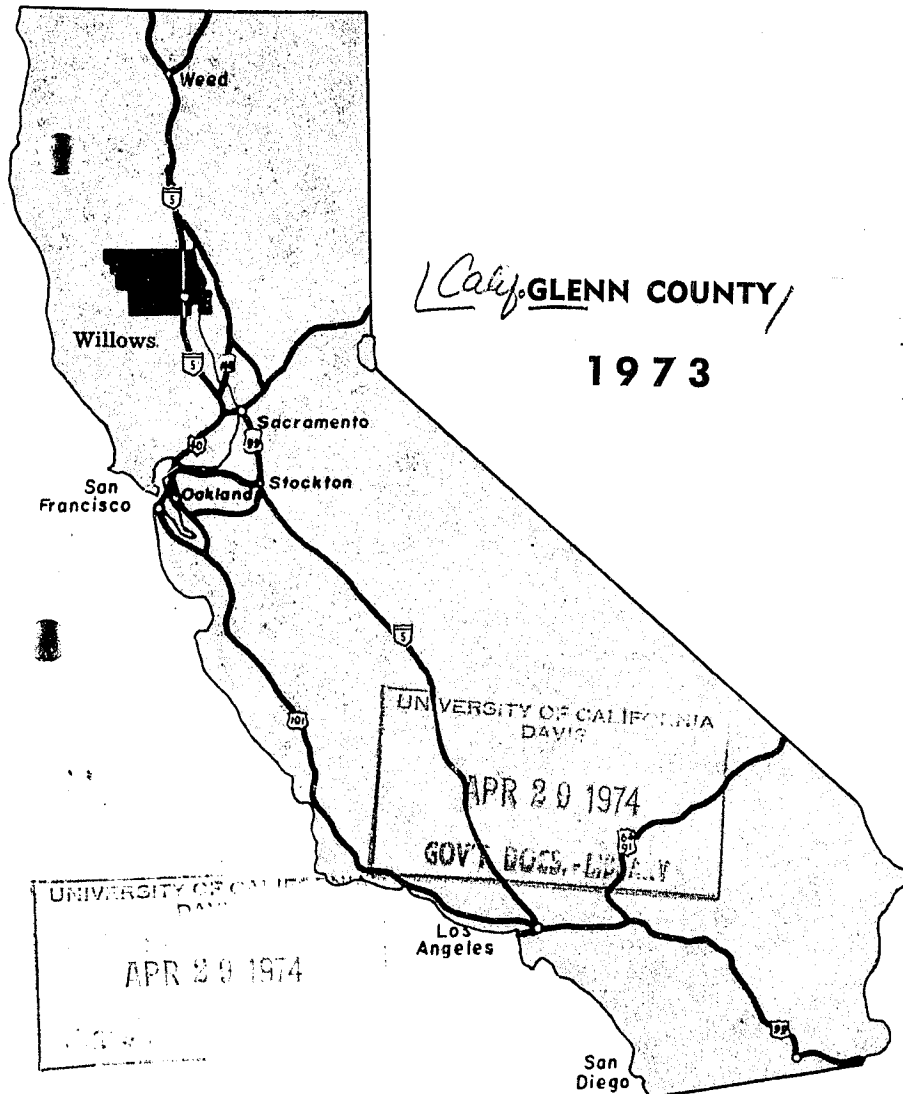

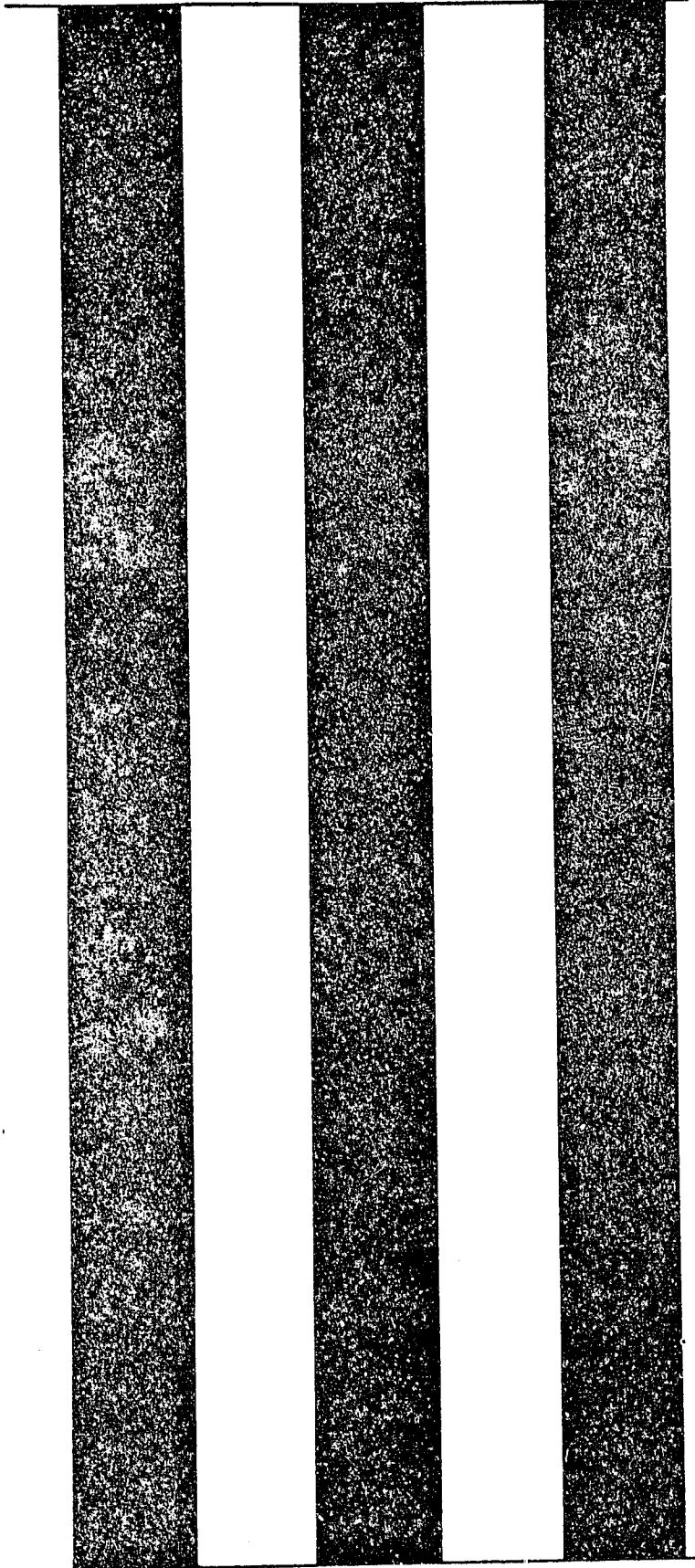

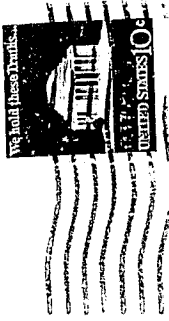
