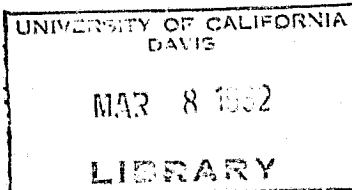

As required by section 65.5 of the Agricultural Code, I herewith submit the 1961 Annual Crop and Livestock Production Report for Marin County.

Milk production, our number one agricultural industry, constitutes 80% of the total agricultural value of the county followed by livestock and field crop production.


Fruit, nut and vegetable crops are becoming almost non-existent as they continue to give way to subdivisions. The urban development, on the other hand, has been beneficial to our nursery industry which had a total sales increase of 9% in 1961 as compared to 1960.

Certain production categories in the report are combined where crops were either of minor importance or it was necessary to protect the interest of the producer of an entire crop. The retail sales figures in nursery production are for informative purposes only and are not included in production totals.

It should be emphasized that the data contained in this report represents gross value and includes the many production and marketing costs which, of course, reflect a much lower net return to the producer.

I wish to express my appreciation to the farmers and producers of the county for their cooperation and to the personnel of the department who were instrumental in gathering and compiling the information contained in this report.

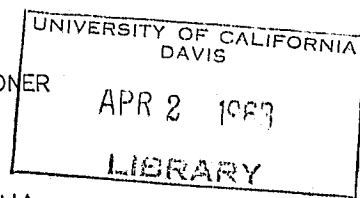

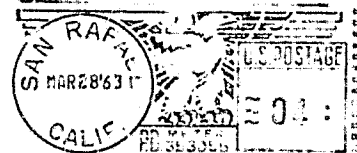

The figures presented in this report represent the gross value of agricultural production and do not reflect net income to the growers.

The combined livestock industry continues to represent about 90% of the total gross agricultural value of the county, of which 73% is derived from milk production alone.


This was a poor pasture year. The resulting high hay prices lessened the net income.
