Gentlemen:

As required by section 65.5 of the Agricultural Code, I herewith submit the 1961 Annual Crop and Livestock Production Report for Marin County.

Milk production, our number one agricultural industry, constitutes 80% of the total agricultural value of the county followed by livestock and field crop production.

Fruit, nut and vegetable crops are becoming almost non-existant as they continue to give way to subdivisions. The urban development, on the other hand, has been beneficial to our nursery industry which had a total sales increase of 9% in 1961 as compared to 1960.

Certain production categories in the report are combined where crops were either of minor importance or it was necessary to protect the interest of the producer of an entire crop. The retail sales figures in nursery production are for informative purposes only and are not included in production totals.

It should be emphasized that the data contained in this report represents gross value and includes the many production and marketing costs which, of course, reflect a much lower net return to the producer.

I wish to express my appreciation to the farmers and producers of the county for their cooperation and to the personnel of the department who were instrumental in gathering and compiling the information contained in this report.

As required by Section 65.5 of the California Agricultural Code, I herewith submit the 1962 Annual Crop and Livestock Production Report for Marin County.

The combined livestock industry constitutes 91% of the gross agricultural value of the county, 77% of which, is derived from milk production alone.

Field crops, fruit, nut and vegetable production show the effects of continued urban expansion. The nursery industry, on the other hand, benefits from this condition — this is especially apparent in retail sales.

Certain categories are combined where production is either of minor importance or it is necessary to protect the interest of producers of entire crops. The retail sales figure in nursery production is for informative purposes only and is not included in production totals.

It should be emphasized that data contained in this report is based on gross value and includes the many production and marketing costs which, of course, reflects a much lower net return to the producer.


