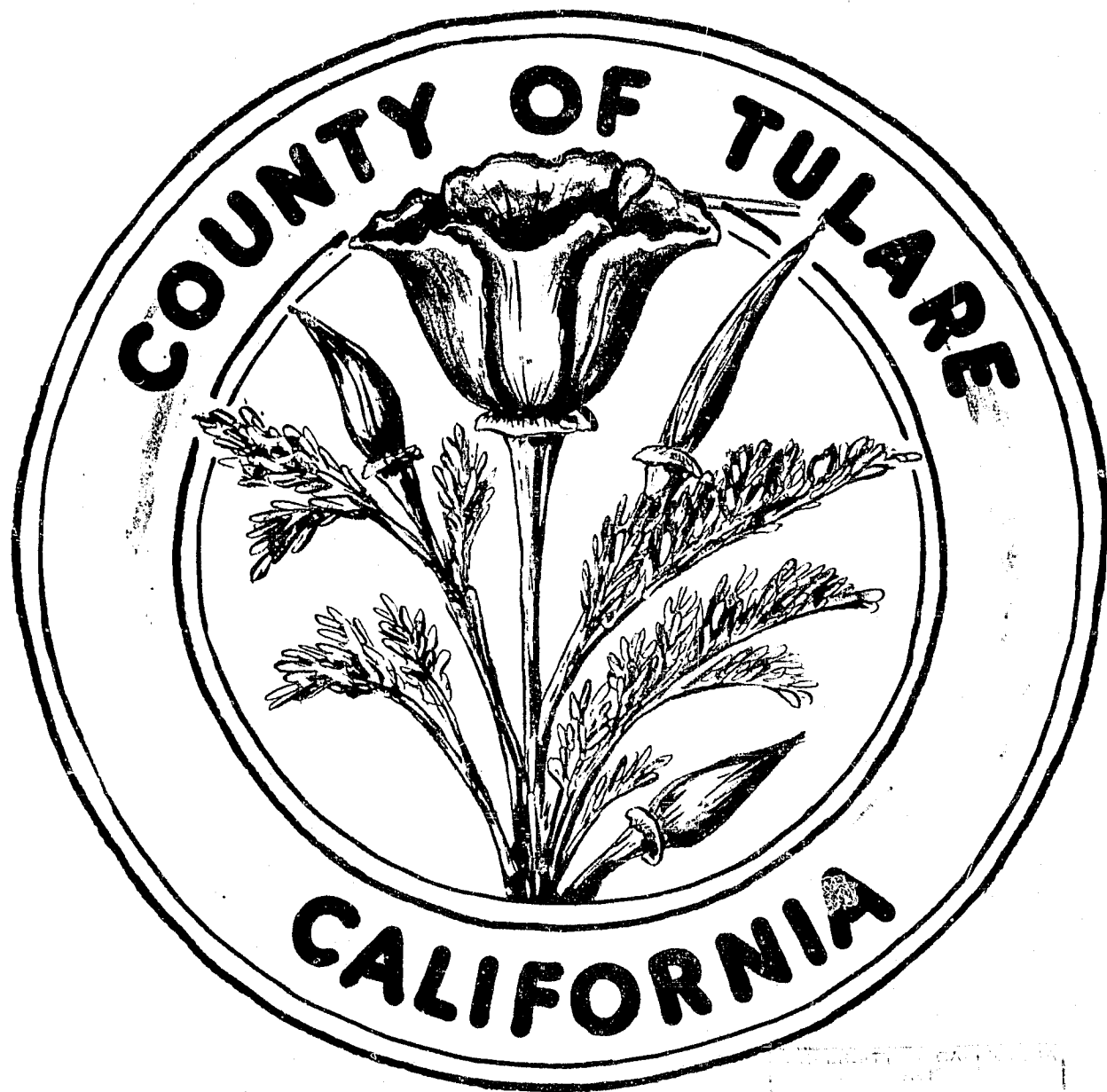

The Agricultural Code states in Section 65.5; "The Commissioner shall compile reports of the condition, acreage, production and value of the agricultural products of his county. The Commissioner may publish such reports and shall transmit a copy thereof to the Director."

Insofar as possible, the acreage represents "net planted" and the value of all crops are f.o.b. basis - not what the farmer received. It is intended that all returns shall mean income to Tulare County and thus include the cost of picking, hauling, packing and otherwise preparing for delivery at the point of packing. This report is as nearly accurate, as is possible for us to make it, on account of the many varied sources of our information.

This year's report has been revised in an effort to obtain state-wide uniformity in agricultural income reports for all counties. The principal change is the inclusion of the previous year's production and return figures for comparison with this year, and a new listing and breakdown for some of the crops produced. Due to this new breakdown, the 1958 figures are not available for some crops.

Because of the change in the reporting system, the 1958 figures in the report may not correspond exactly to those figures for the same crops in last year's report.

Our entire staff assisted in the compilation of these figures. We are indebted to the many individuals and organizations for their help and cooperation in making available to this department their records and information. We wish to express our sincere appreciation for this valuable help.

It is intended that all returns shall mean income to Tulare County and thus include the cost of picking, hauling, packing and otherwise preparing for delivery at the point of packing. This report is as nearly accurate, as is possible for us to make it, on account of the many and varied sources of our information.

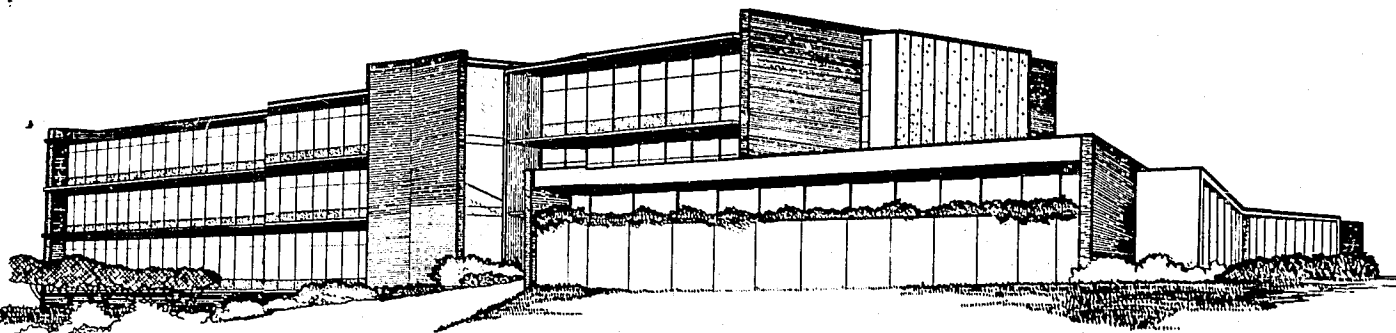

Insofar as possible, the acreage represents "net planted" and the value of all crops are f. o. b. basis - not what the farmer received. While this is income to Tulare County, the cost of producing, picking, hauling, packing and otherwise preparing for market is deducted from these figures, and does not necessarily show the financial benefits that the farmer receives from any given commodity.

The information in this report is from many and varied sources and is as accurate as is possible. Our entire staff assisted in the compilation of these figures; also we are indebted to the many individuals and organizations for their help and cooperation in making available to this department their records and information. 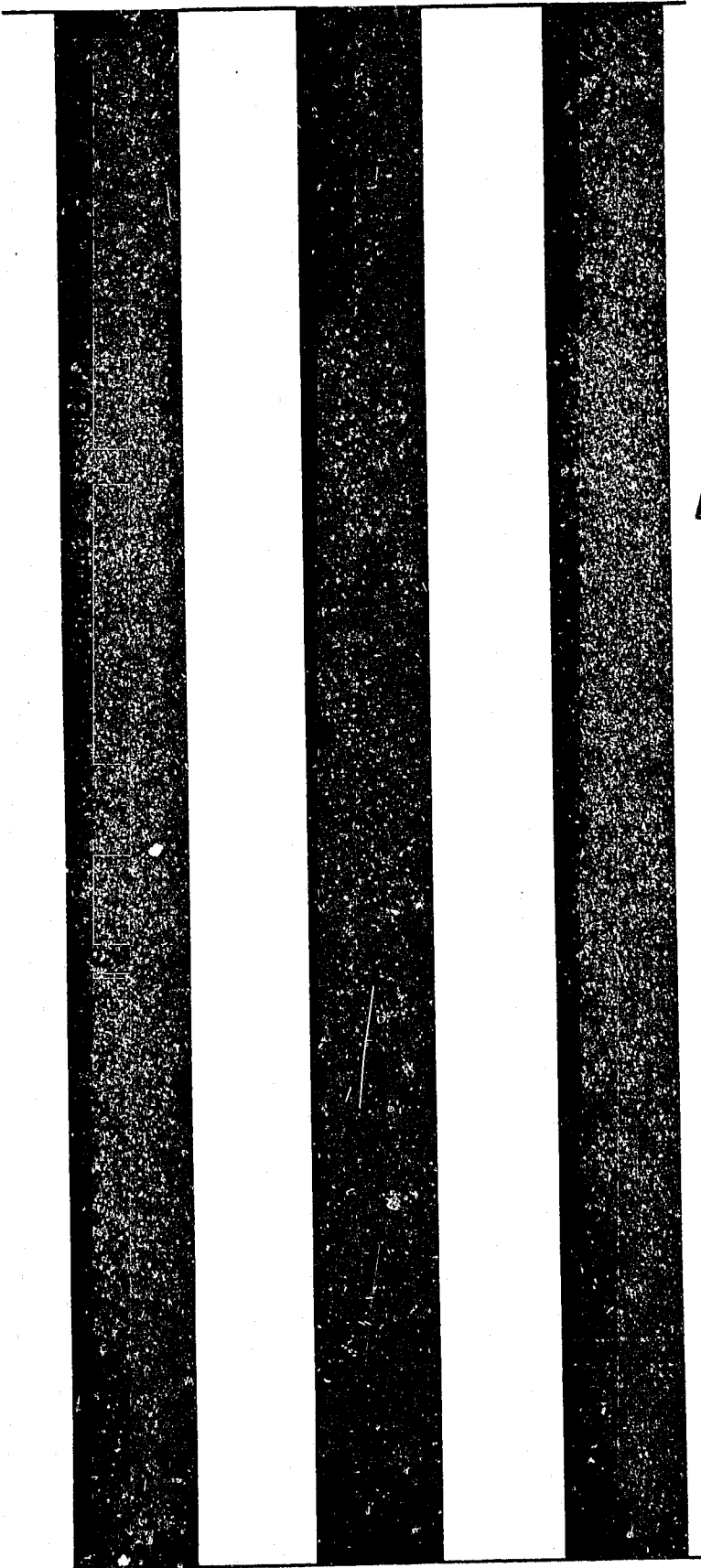

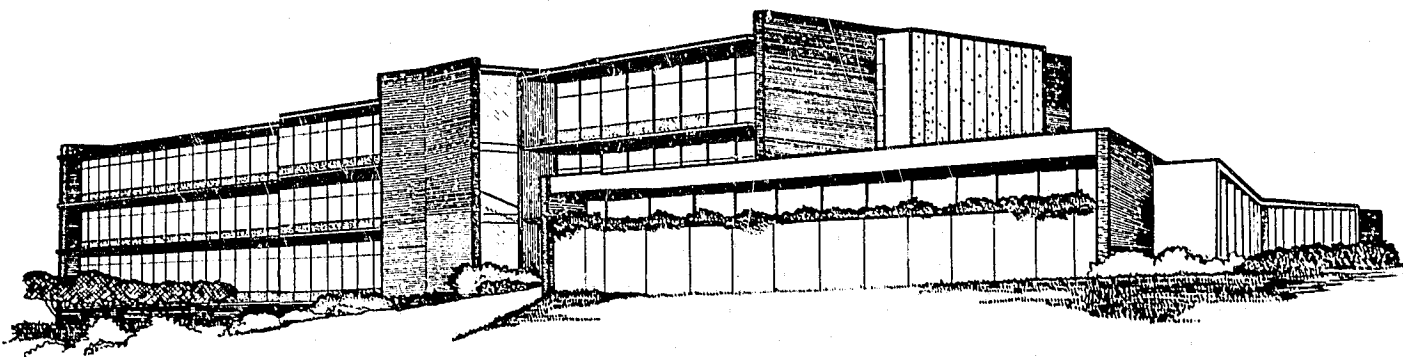

Insofar as possible, the acreage represents "net planted" and the value of all crops is f.o.b. basis - not what the farmer received. While this is income to Tulare County, the cost of producing, picking, hauling, packing and otherwise preparing for market is deducted from these figures, and does not necessarily show the financial benefits that the farmer receives from any given commodity.

The information in this report is from many and varied sources and is as accurate as is possible. Our entire staff assisted in the compilation of these figures, also we are indebted to the many individuals and organizations for their help and cooperation in making available to this department their records and information. We wish to express our sincere appreciation for this valuable help.

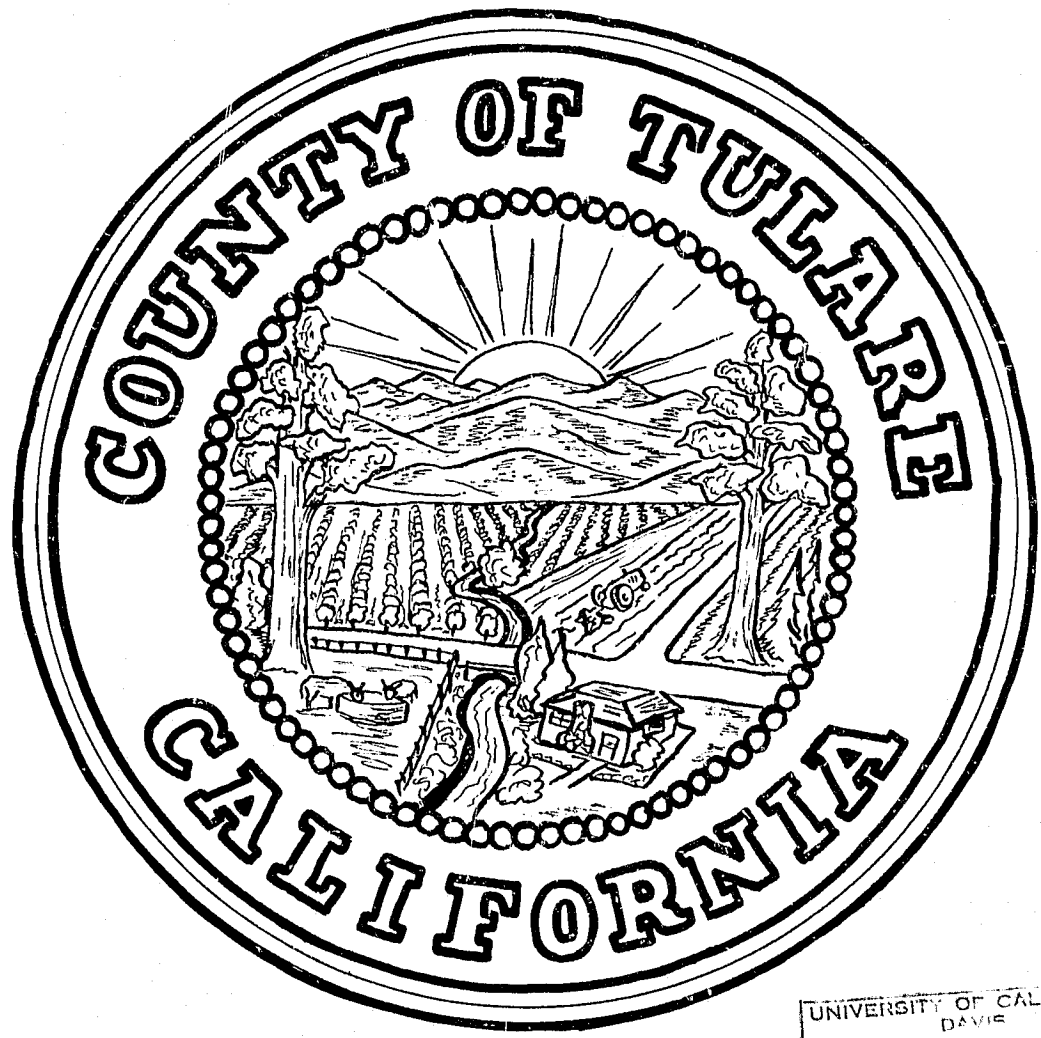

Insofar as possible, the acreage represents "net planted" and the value of all crops is f.o.b. basis - not what the farmer received. While this is income to Tulare County, the cost of producing, picking, hauling, packing and otherwise preparing for market is deducted from these figures, and does not necessarily show the financial benefits that the farmer receives from any given commodity.

The information in this report is from many and varied sources and is as accurate as is possible. Our entire staff assisted in the compilation of these figures; also we are indebted to the many individuals and organizations for their help and cooperation in making available to this department their records and information. We wish to express our sincere appreciation for this valuable help.

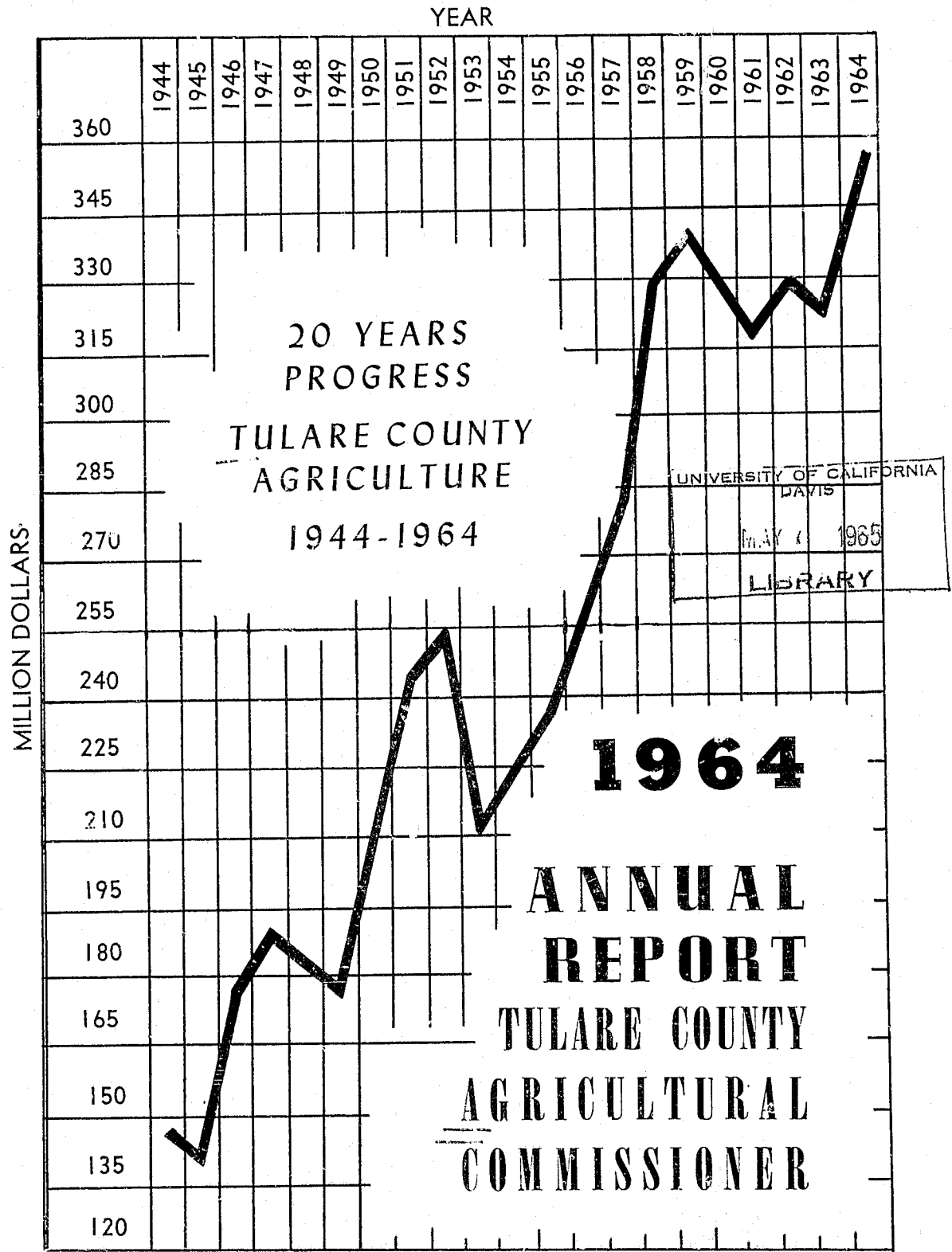

While this is income to Tulare County, the cost of producing, picking, hauling, packing and otherwise preparing for market is deducted from these figures, and does not necessarily show the financial benefits that the farmer receives from any given commodity.

The information in this report is from many and varied sources and is as accurate as is possible.
