

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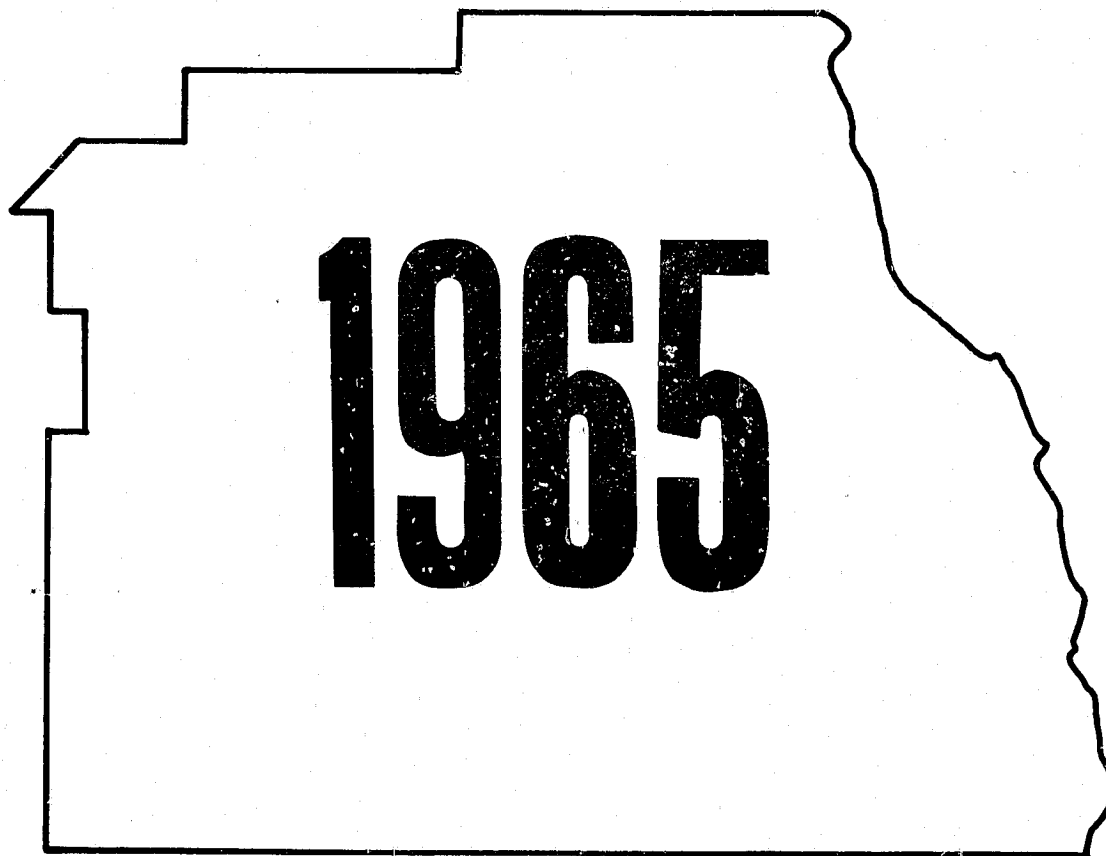



The Agricultural Code states in Section 65.5; "The Commissioner shall compile reports of the condition, acreage, production and value of the agricultural products of his county. The Commissioner may publish such reports and shall transmit a copy thereof to the Director."

Insofar as possible, the acreage represents "net planted" and the value of all crops is f.o.b. basis - not what the farmer received. While this is income to Tulare County, the cost of producing, picking, hauling, packing and otherwise preparing for market is deducted from these figures, and does not necessarily show the financial benefits that the farmer receives from any given commodity.

The information in this report is from many and varied sources and is as accurate as is possible. Our entire staff assisted in the compilation of these figures, also we are indebted to the many individuals and organizations for their help and cooperation in making available to this department their records and information. We wish to express our sincere appreciation for this valuable help.

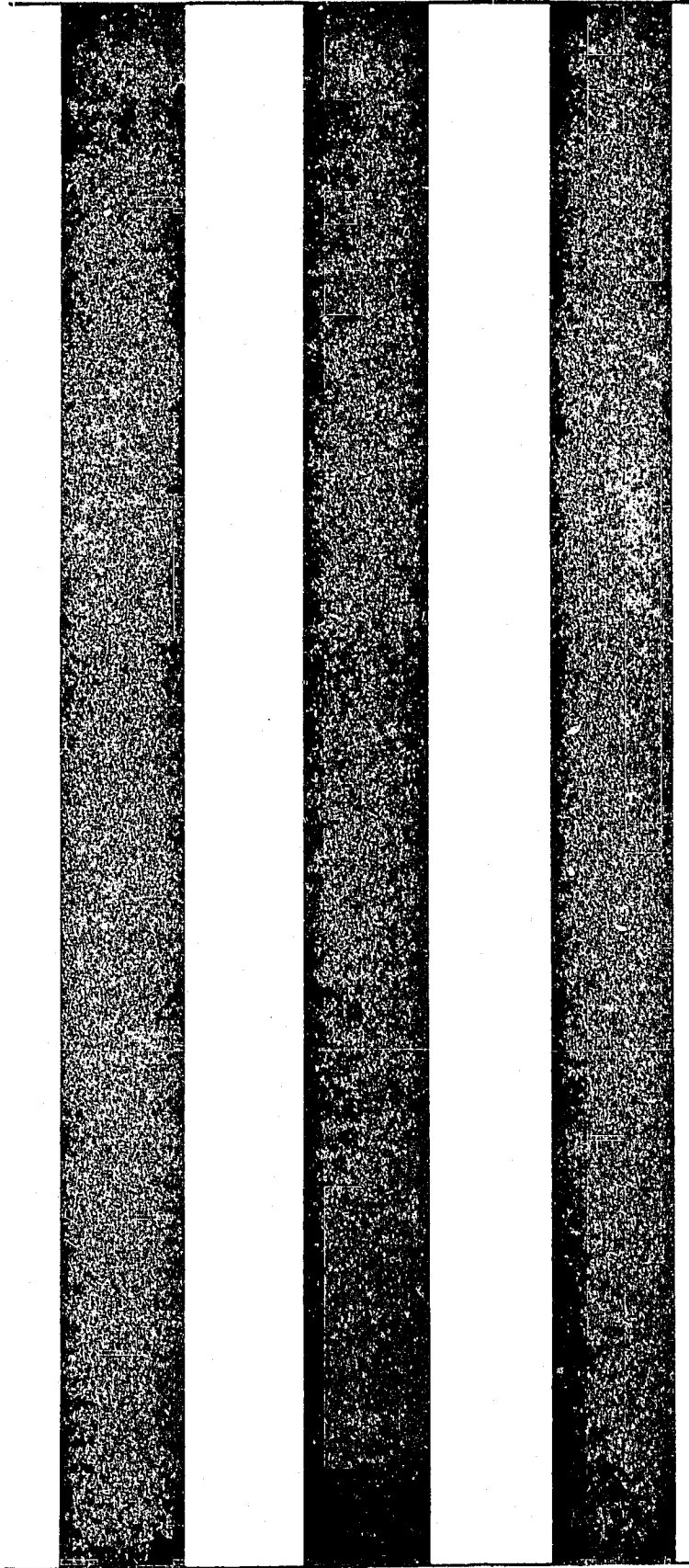



The Agricultural Code states in Section 65.5; "The Commissioner shall compile reports of the condition, acreage, production and value of the agricultural products of his county. The Commissioner may publish such reports and shall transmit a copy thereof to the Director."

Insofar as possible, the acreage represents "net planted" and the value of all crops is f.o.b. basis - not what the farmer received. While this is income to Tulare County, the cost of producing, picking, hauling, packing and otherwise preparing for market is deducted from these figures, and does not necessarily show the financial benefits that the farmer receives from any given commodity.

The information in this report is from many and varied sources and is as accurate as is possible. Our entire staff assisted in the compilation of these figures, also we are indebted to the many individuals and organizations for their help and cooperation in making available to this department their records and information. We wish to express our sincere appreciation for this valuable help.

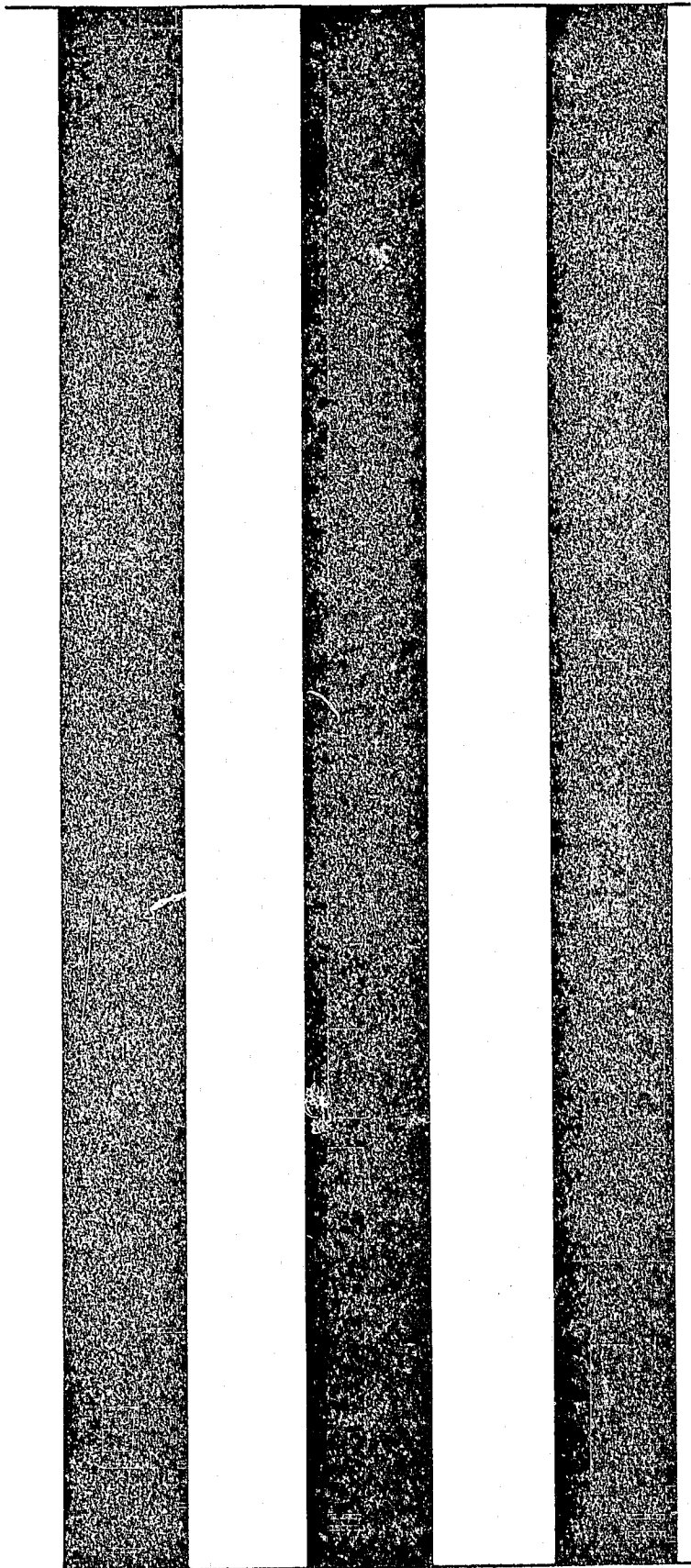

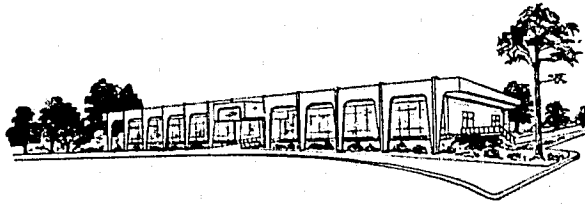

The Agricultural Code states in Section 2279; "The Commissioner shall compile reports of the condition, acreage, production and value of the agricultural products of his county. The Commissioner may publish such reports and shall transmit a copy thereof to the Director."

Insofar as possible, the acreage represents "net planted" and the value of all crops is f.o.b. basis - not what the farmer received. While this is income to Tulare County, the cost of producing, picking, hauling, packing and otherwise preparing for market is deducted from these figures, and does not necessarily show the financial benefits that the farmer receives from any given commodity.

The information in this report is from many and varied sources and is as accurate as is possible. Our entire staff assisted in the compilation of these figures, also we are indebted to the many individuals and organizations for their help and cooperation in making available to this department their records and information. We wish to express our sincere appreciation for this valuable help.

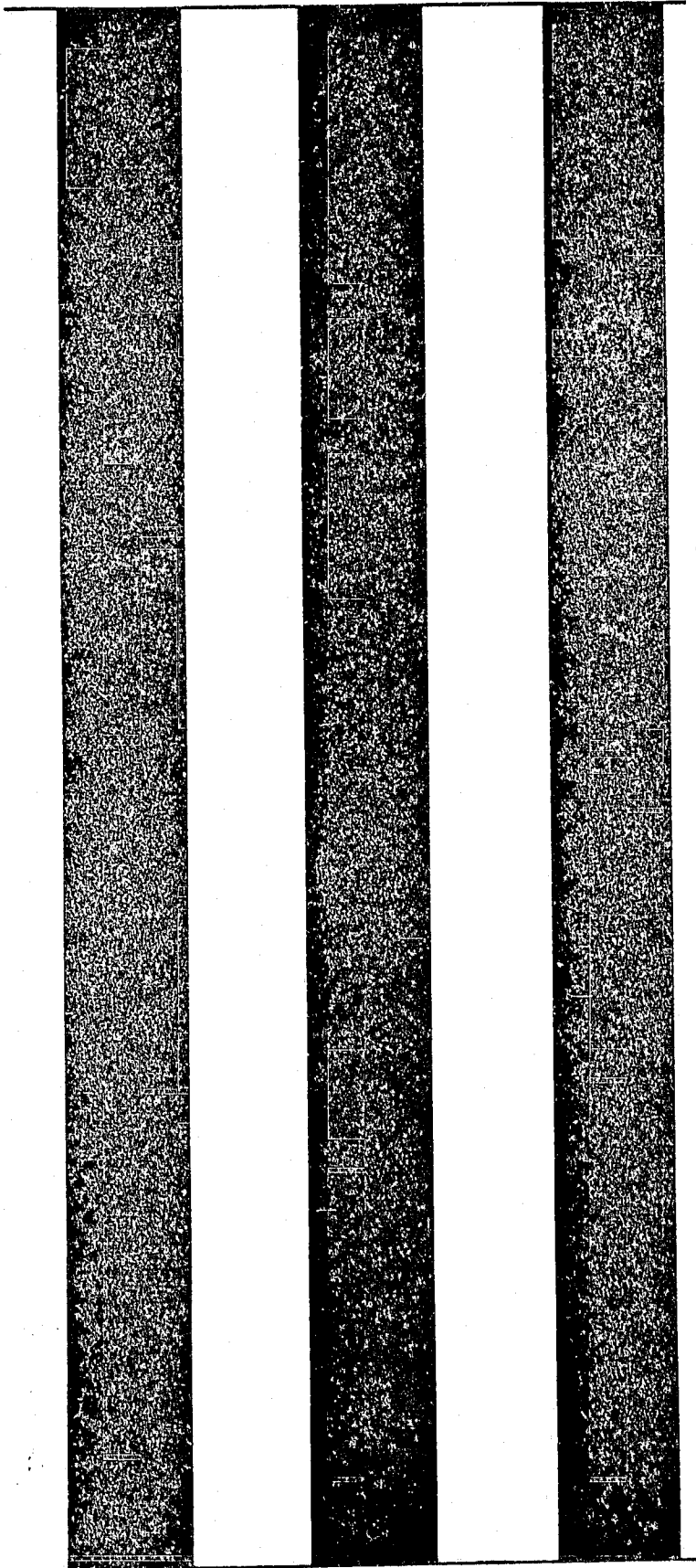

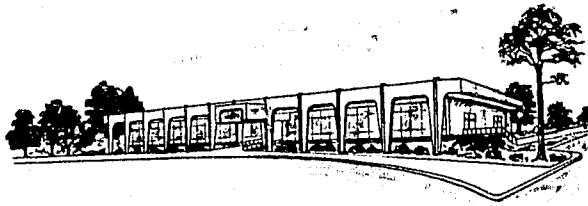

The Agricultural Code states in Section 2279; "The Commissioner shall compile reports of the condition, acreage, production and value of the agricultural products of his county. The Commissioner may publish such reports and shall transmit a copy thereof to the Director."

Insofar as possible, the acreage represents "net planted" and the value of all crops is f.o.b. basis -- not what the farmer received. While this is income to Tulare County, the cost of producing, picking, hauling, packing and otherwise preparing for market is deducted from these figures, and does not necessarily show the financial benefits that the farmer receives from any given commodity.

The information in this report is from many and varied sources and is as accurate as is possible. Our entire staff assisted in the compilation of these figures, also we are indebted to the many individuals and organizations for their help and cooperation in making available to this department their records and information. We wish to express our sincere appreciation for this valuable help.

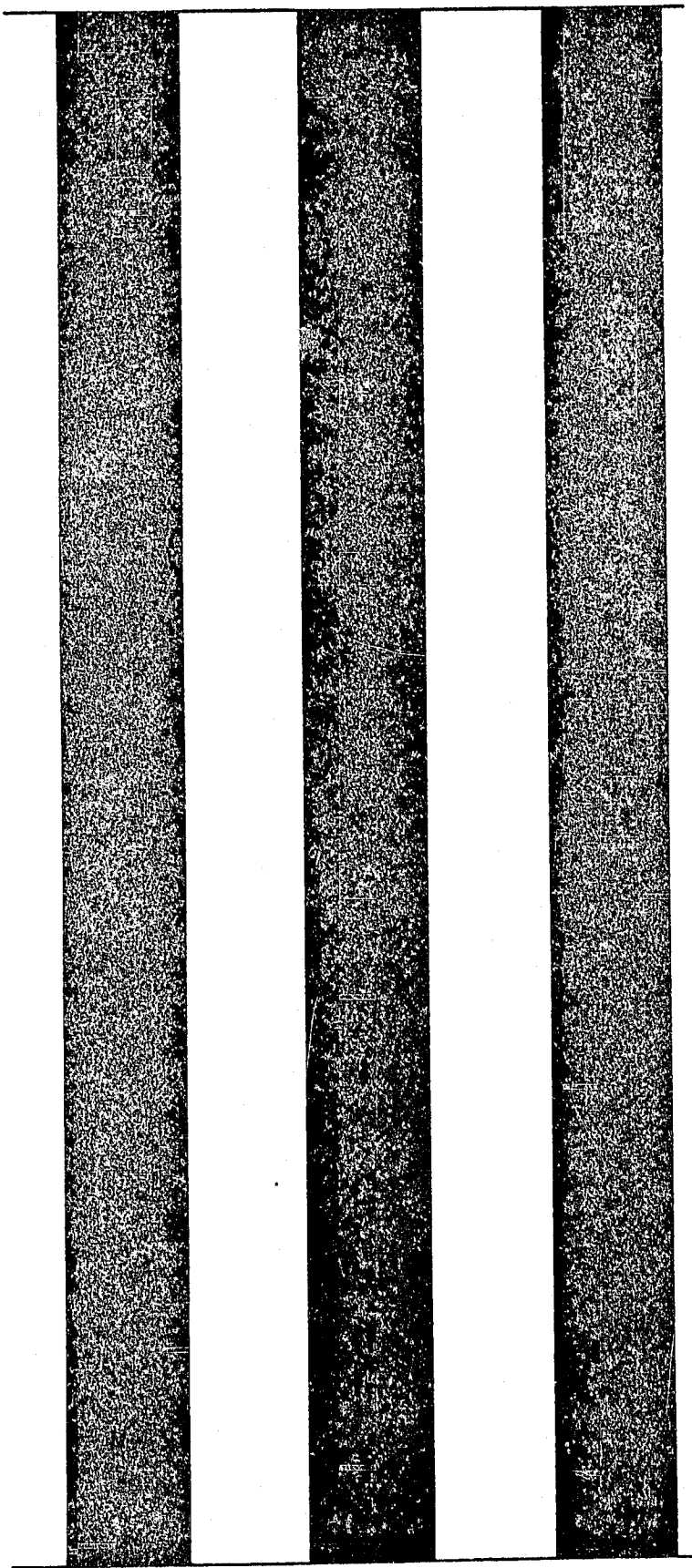

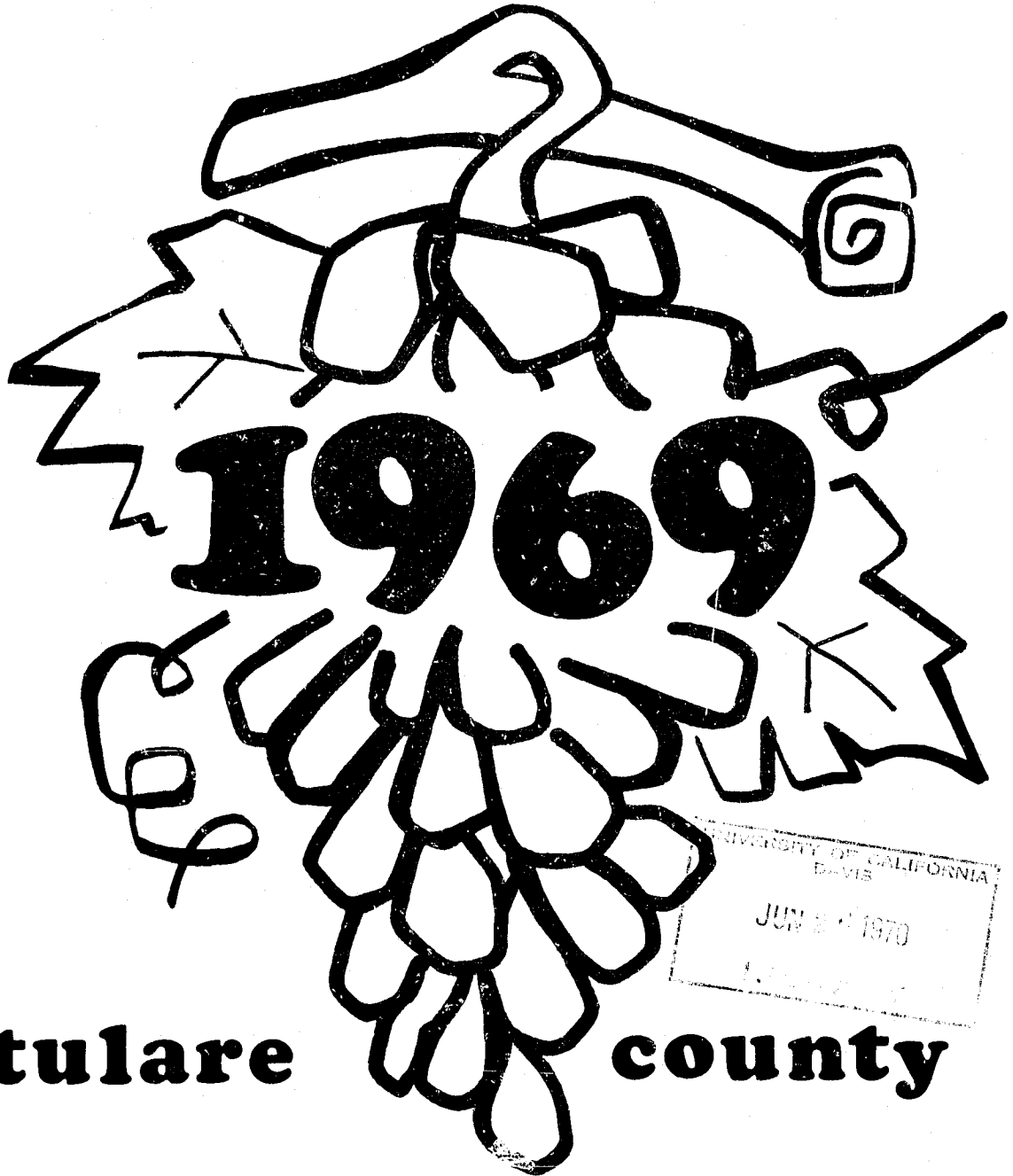

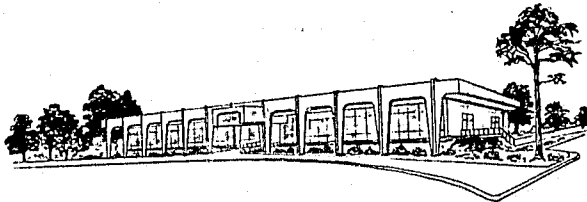

The Agricultural Code states in Section 2279; "The Commissioner shall compile reports of the condition, acreage, production and value of the agricultural products of his county. The Commissioner may publish such reports and shall transmit a copy thereof to the Director."

Insofar as possible, the acreage represents "net planted" and the value of all crops is f.o.b. basis - not what the farmer received. While this is income to Tulare County, the cost of producing, picking, hauling, packing and otherwise preparing for market is deducted from these figures, and does not necessarily show the financial benefits that the farmer receives from any given commodity.

The information in this report is from many and varied sources and is as accurate as is possible. Our entire staff assisted in the compilation of these figures, also we are indebted to the many individuals and organizations for their help and cooperation in making available to this department their records and information. We wish to express our sincere appreciation for this valuable help.
